

# Boondall station accessibility upgrade



## Foundation works – February 2018

Queensland Rail is striving to become a modern, customer-focused rail service and is investing significantly to upgrade a number of stations to ensure that all customers can travel safely and easily.

Early works for the Boondall station accessibility upgrade will soon commence with the installation of overhead masts. To facilitate this activity, Queensland Rail plans to establish foundations for the masts in late February.

When complete, station improvements will include a new pedestrian footbridge with lift access, raised section of platform at assisted boarding points and upgraded hearing augmentation loop and tactile platform surfaces.

Alternative access to platform 2 exists at the southern end of Aberdeen Parade.
