

Shorncliffe station renewal project and accessibility upgrade

PROJECT UPDATE – OCTOBER 2022

Queensland Rail is seeking feedback on the new concept designs for the Shorncliffe station renewal project and accessibility upgrade.

The Shorncliffe station renewal project and accessibility upgrade is now part of Queensland Rail's *Station Accessibility Upgrade Program*, which focuses on upgrading station infrastructure to provide easier access to public transport.

We are currently completing the concept design phase of the project to ensure the features of Shorncliffe station's upgrade will provide a better and more accessible travel experience while retaining the historically significant station building and air raid shelter.

Restoration works will focus on:

- the station building, an iconic feature of the local community requiring extensive works to preserve its heritage for future generations
- restoring the station building and air raid shelter near to their original 1897 footprint.

Shorncliffe station accessibility upgrade will include:

- raising the full length of the platform
- installing wayfinding signage, tactile indicators, accessible ramps and seats, public address system and hearing aid loop technology.

Other new station features include bike storage, unisex accessible toilets, upgraded lighting, telecommunications and CCTV, restoration of the existing awning and installation of new awnings to cover 60 per cent of the platform.

The new concept designs reveal the integration between the restoration and the accessible components of the upgrade.
