South Brisbane Station Upgrade Project

About the project

The South Brisbane Station Upgrade Project is part of an infrastructure investment program by the Queensland Government to improve around 50 stations in the City network.

The City Network Station Upgrade Program is being delivered by Queensland Rail and TransLink to improve station facilities and provide customers with increased comfort while they undertake their journey.

The South Brisbane Station Upgrade Project will restore the heritage-listed station and improve facilities and access for all our customers.

A historical, cultural and entertainment hub

South Brisbane station is an important hub in Brisbane's railway network. It provides a transit centre for regular commuters and those visiting Brisbane's cultural precinct, South Bank's attractions, or West End's bohemian scene.

Built in 1891, the station has significant historic value and is listed on the State Heritage Register.

The redevelopment of the South Bank precinct for the 1988 Brisbane Expo was the last time significant work was undertaken on the station.

Project outcomes

The works at South Brisbane station will restore and preserve the heritage-listed building, improve station access for people with a disability, and enhance customer facilities.

Improving access and facilities

The South Brisbane Station Upgrade Project will improve station facilities, security and comfort for all our customers. Improvements to disability access will include:

- a new accessible ticket office window
- raising the height of platform one
- a new accessible toilet.

General station improvements will include:

- new electronic passenger information display screens
- additional security CCTV
- refurbishment of existing toilets
- refurbishment of the subway with energy efficient lighting, new cladding, floor and ceiling finishes.

Preserving history

The South Brisbane Station Upgrade Project will restore and preserve one of Brisbane's historic rail landmarks.

Work includes:

- paint removal and restoration of the masonry and façade of the building
- restoration of heritage furniture, fascias and awnings.

Queensland Rail has consulted closely with the Department of Environment and Resource Management and has engaged the services of a heritage architect consultant to ensure the site's historical integrity is maintained.

Station closure

Due to the extent of construction, which includes structural maintenance and platform raising, the station must close to ensure everyone's safety.

No train services will stop at the station for a six week period, from Monday 31 October to Friday 9 December.

Alternative transport

The closure only affects customers wanting to get on or off at South Brisbane station, not those travelling through the station.

Customers can access regular bus services on the nearby South East Busway at the Cultural Centre and South Bank busway stations.

Customers traveling on go card are reminded to touch on and touch off as usual to continue their journey.

If paper tickets are required these can be purchased from the busway station fare machines.

A shuttle bus will be available for customers already travelling on a valid fare. This service will operate between South Brisbane and South Bank stations, with an optional stop at the Queensland Art Gallery.

The shuttle bus service will coordinate with the regular train timetable. Customers using this service should allow extra travel time to complete their journey.

A temporary ticket office will be available at South Brisbane station to purchase paper tickets and provide train information.

Shuttle bus stops are located at:

- South Brisbane directly opposite the station on Grey Street
- South Bank on Tribune Street
- The Queensland Art Gallery on Stanley Street.
