Day 1 Monday Depart Cairns on coach for Karumba. Travel through World Heritage-listed rainforest past Kuranda, through Atherton, Mount Garnet and Croydon before arriving in Karumba. Overnight End of the Road Motel, Karumba.

Day 2 Tuesday Enjoy a day of leisure exploring Karumba. For a little more excitement, try your luck with a spot of barramundi fishing or take a cruise along the beautiful Norman River. Overnight End of the Road Motel, Karumba. (B)

Day 3 Wednesday Transfer back to Normanton then step aboard for a trip "from nowhere to nowhere" on the Gulflander. Travel through some of the most remote and inaccessible countryside in Queensland, then enjoy an afternoon of exploring Croydon. Overnight Club Hotel, Croydon. (B, MT)

Day 4 Thursday Depart for Georgetown, arriving in Forsayth before transferring to Cobbold Gorge for a peaceful boat cruise through ancient sandstone cliffs. Overnight Forsayth Tourist Park. (D)

Day 5 Friday Enjoy an early breakfast then board the Savannahlander for the journey to Mount Surprise. Continue through to Undara Experience and spend the afternoon exploring the amazing Undara Lava Tubes with a Savannah guide. Retire to your very own beautifully restored, turn of the century Queensland Rail carriage. Overnight Undara Lodge. (B, D)

Day 6 Saturday Depart on the Savannahlander, and travel through the remote reaches of the Outback before passing the mountain village of Kuranda and World Heritage-listed rainforest on the way back to Cairns. (B)
