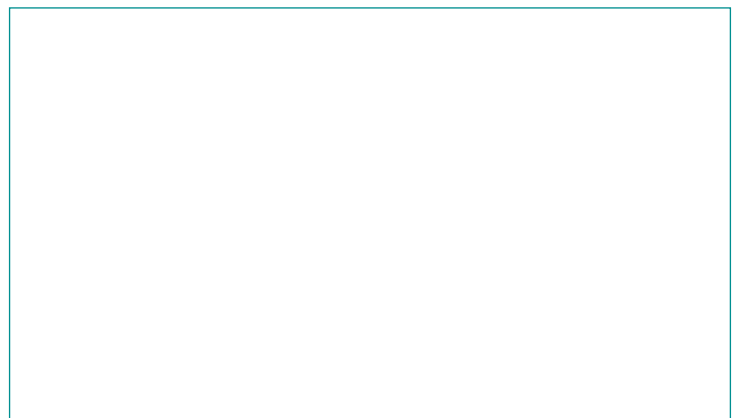
Day 5 Monday Enjoy breakfast before checking out and travelling to your departure point (own expense). (B)
