This year marks the 120th anniversary of the first passenger service to Kuranda. Construction of the Kuranda line was an epic challenge back then, and still a tremendous feat of engineering today. This splendid monument occupies a great place in the history of the region and stands as a grand testament to the ingenuity and ambitions of the people of north Queensland.
