

Morayfield station accessibility upgrade



PROJECT UPDATE – FEBRUARY 2020

The Morayfield station accessibility upgrade is part of the State Government's \$357 million investment to upgrade stations across the South East Queensland network, making them accessible for all customers.

Project progress

The following activities were recently undertaken at Morayfield:

- opening of the new lifts (early January)
- reopening of bus lane and bus stop shelter
- bicycle enclosure fit-out
- station identification and wayfinding signage
- station entrance, paths and landscaping works.

Upcoming works

In the coming weeks, customers and the community can expect to see the following activities:

- final platform surfacing works
- completion of bicycle enclosure fit-out
- bicycle racks – eastern and western sides
- installation of platform furniture
- final carpark and entrance works
- landscaping and fencing.

Please take care around the work zones.



Construction impacts

Normal working hours are 6am to 5pm Monday to Saturday. Construction activities may involve:

- noise associated with heavy machinery
- temporary changes to station access paths
- changed traffic and parking conditions
- increased vehicle movements near works
- mobile lighting towers for night works.

Residents and the local community will be given advance notification of construction activities likely to cause impacts, including after hours work (nights and Sundays, as required).
