

Strathpine station accessibility upgrade



PROJECT UPDATE – NOVEMBER 2019

The Strathpine station accessibility upgrade is part of the State Government's \$357 million program to upgrade stations across the South East Queensland network, making them accessible for all customers.

Project progress

In recent weeks, the following activities were undertaken at Strathpine:

- opening of the new footbridge (stair-only access until lift completion)
- commencement of bicycle enclosure works
- paving – platform 2/3
- shelter works – platform 2/3
- lighting installations – platform 2/3
- ongoing lift installation
- removal of the temporary footbridge.

Upcoming works

In the coming weeks, customers and the community can expect to see the following activities:

- completion of bicycle enclosure structural steel
- access roadworks – eastern carpark
- entrance fencing – platform 1
- lighting and signage works
- ongoing lift installation
- paving works – platform 2/3.

Please follow all directional signage and take care around the work zones.



Construction impacts

Normal working hours are 6am to 5pm, Monday to Saturday. Construction activities may involve:

- noise associated with heavy machinery
- temporary changes to access paths throughout the station precinct
- ramp access to platform 2/3 (at level crossing) closed
- changed traffic and parking conditions
- increased vehicle movements near works
- mobile lighting towers for night works.
