

Strathpine station accessibility upgrade



PROJECT UPDATE – OCTOBER 2019

The Strathpine station accessibility upgrade is part of the State Government's \$357 million program to upgrade stations across the South East Queensland network, making them accessible for all customers.

Project progress

During September, the following activities were undertaken:

- concreting raised section – platform 2/3
- commenced shelter installation – platform 2/3
- stormwater drainage works – platform 2/3
- electrical and communications installations – platform 1.

Upcoming works

In the coming weeks, customers and the community can expect to see the following activities:

- commencement of bicycle enclosure works
- paving – platform 2/3
- shelter works – platform 2/3
- lighting installations – platform 2/3
- ongoing lift car installations.

Please follow all directional signage and take care around the work zones.

Construction impacts

Normal working hours are 6am to 5pm, Monday to Saturday. Construction activities may involve:

- noise associated with heavy machinery
- temporary changes to access paths throughout the station precinct
- ramp access to platform 2/3 (at level crossing) closed
- changed traffic and parking conditions
- increased vehicle movements near works
- mobile lighting towers for night works.
