



Bundamba station accessibility upgrade

Quarterly project update | April 2024

The Bundamba station accessibility upgrade is part of the State Government's ongoing investment to upgrade stations to make them accessible for everyone.



Project benefits

Bundamba station is being upgraded to make it more accessible, and easier for customers and the community to travel on our network. The new, modern station will help people in wheelchairs, parents with prams and those travelling with luggage or who are injured use the station with ease.



Construction progress

Since the closure of Bundamba station on Monday 8 January 2024, major work has been progressing on site including:

- ✓ site establishment
- ✓ installation of temporary pedestrian footbridge
- ✓ installation of lift shaft
- ✓ extension of station platforms
- ✓ kiss 'n' ride works near the station carpark
- ✓ installation of concrete platform edges
- ✓ construction of platform foundations
- ✓ demolition of lower Mining Street retaining walls
- ✓ installation of stormwater and in-ground services.

Upcoming works

You can expect to see the following upcoming activities on site:

- platform raising works
- station building improvements works including accessible toilets and ticket windows
- kiss 'n' ride works near station carpark and accessible carpark improvements
- relocation and commissioning of signalling infrastructure
- installation of platform shelters, station furniture and customer information infrastructure.

Works will generally take place between 6am and 6pm Monday to Saturday, unless notified. Every effort will be made to carry out these works with respect for our neighbours and customers.



Alternative transport

Shuttle bus 501 continues to operate between Bundamba and Booval stations to keep customers moving during the station upgrade.
