## WORKS NOTICE

## Day and night works

### Monday 11 to Friday 29 April 2022

As part of the South Bank platform 1 upgrade, Queensland Rail will undertake platform works between **Monday 11 and Friday 29 April** (weather and construction conditions permitting).

For the safety of our customers and construction workers, some of these works have been scheduled when there is reduced rail traffic. Nearby residents may experience some noise associated with construction activity, machinery and truck movements.

A single lane closure will be in place on Tribune Street, South Brisbane to assist with construction works occurring over weeknights (see table below for details).

Every effort will be made to minimise disruption and we thank you for your patience while we upgrade platform 1 at South Bank station.

Tribune Street, South Brisbane (single lane closure)	A single lane road closure will be in place: <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>when weeknight works are being carried out.</li></ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>Single lane closure between Grey and Colchester Streets (concrete pump in operation)</li><li>Northbound detour via Ernest Street and Colchester Street</li><li>Southbound detour via Stanley Street, Annerley Road, Stephens Road, Vulture Street, Ernest Street and Colchester Street.</li></ul>
Southpoint entrance and Vulture Street, South Brisbane	Platform 1 access via the Vulture Street pedestrian ramp will be closed: <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>as required, during night works from <b>Monday 11 to Friday 15 April</b>.</li></ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>Movement of personnel and delivery of material between Vulture and Tribune Streets (via platform 1).</li></ul>
