

After hours works Banyo station



What?

In preparation for the closure of Banyo station for main construction of the accessibility upgrade, Queensland Rail's project team will undertake after hours activities throughout the station precinct.



When?

Overnight works will be undertaken on **Sunday 21 January 2024, from 6pm until 5am** the next day.

Sunday night's rail services will be unaffected by these activities.

Banyo station will close to customers from Monday 22 January and the upgraded station will reopen in the second half of 2024. During the station closure alternative transport (shuttle bus) will operate between Banyo and Northgate stations to connect customers with rail services.



Where?

Works will occur throughout the Banyo station precinct, including platforms, station carparks and rail corridor.

Sections of surrounding footpath areas will progressively close with pedestrian detours in place.



Impacts



Operation of machinery and equipment and the movement of trucks and vehicles with flashing lights and reversing beepers



After hours activities



Presence of project personnel and installation of temporary fencing



Lighting towers at night
