

Night works – overhead line infrastructure

Wednesday 3 and Thursday 4 August 2022

Queensland Rail will undertake overhead line infrastructure (mast foundation) works at Lindum station over two nights on **Wednesday 3 and Thursday 4 August**, each night from **7pm to 6am** the next day (weather and construction conditions permitting).

For safety, these works can only be undertaken at night when rail traffic is reduced and there are fewer people around the station precinct.

To support works, some sections of the North Road station carpark may be unavailable each night.

Residents near the station may experience noise associated with excavation, concrete pumping, truck movements and construction activity around the work zones and station precinct.

Every effort will be made to minimise disruption and we thank you for your patience during these important works.
