WORKS NOTICE

Day, night and weekend works

Saturday 30 July to Wednesday 31 August

As part of the South Bank platform 1 upgrade, Queensland Rail will continue platform works for the rest of July and throughout August (weather and construction conditions permitting).

For the safety of our customers and construction workers, some works have been scheduled when there is reduced rail traffic, when platform 1 is temporarily closed or during a planned track closure. Nearby residents may experience some noise associated with construction activity, machinery and truck movements.

Excavation, concrete pouring, service installation and roofing works involving: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> the use of loud hand-held tools and powered equipment, including jackhammers concrete pouring from the closed section of the Vulture Street footpath structural steel, roof sheeting and plumbing works installation of wall and ceiling sheeting operation of trucks and machinery with flashing lights and reversing beepers, including concrete saw cutter and line pump, vacuum excavation truck, excavators with rock breakers, scissor lift and forklift movement of personnel and vehicles around the station precinct and Vulture Street partial demolition of the lift structure for lift modification works excavation and concrete pours operation of forklifts with flashing lights and reversing beepers movement of personnel and material between Vulture and Tribune Streets (via platform 1) preparation for installation of station infrastructure.
	Weeknight works from 6.30pm to 4am throughout August. Works will take place intermittently as required. There will be some nights without any works.	
	The platform will remain open on every weekend in August.	
Southpoint entrance and Vulture Street, South Brisbane Vulture Street footpath and lift closures on 30 and 31 July and day time through to mid-August 2022	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> The station side of the Vulture Street footpath will be closed between Southpoint near Grey Street and the platform 2/3 ramp (still open) Traffic control and directional signage will be in place. Please ensure you take care around the work zones Alternative access to platforms from Vulture Street will be via the Grey Street entrance, Vulture Street underpass and via Tribune Street platform entrances The Platform 1 lift will be closed when the footpath is closed. Please access the station via the above or seek assistance from station staff. 	
	There may be times at the Southpoint entrance when service works will take place. Access to the station platform will be maintained at all times.	

Every effort will be made to minimise disruption and we thank you for your patience while we upgrade platform 1 at South Bank station.
