Due to the recent inclement weather encountered, additional night works are required for the South Bank platform 1 upgrade. Queensland Rail will undertake additional platform works in **December 2021 and January 2022** (weather and construction conditions permitting).

For the safety of our customers and construction workers, these works have been scheduled in the evenings when there is reduced rail traffic. Nearby residents may experience some noise associated with construction activity, machinery and truck movements.

A single lane closure will be in place on Tribune Street, South Brisbane to assist with construction works (see table below for details).

Every effort will be made to minimise disruption and we thank you for your patience while we upgrade platform 1 at South Bank station.
