WORKS NOTICE

Works and lane closure notification

October 2021

As part of the South Bank platform 1 upgrade, Queensland Rail will undertake platform works in late-October (weather and construction conditions permitting).

For the safety of our customers and construction workers, these works have been scheduled over a weekend platform 1 closure when rail traffic does not service the platform and customers cannot access the platform.

Nearby residents may experience some noise associated with construction activity, machinery and truck movements. Mobile lighting towers will be used during the night works.

A single lane closure will be in place on Vulture Street, South Brisbane to assist with construction works (see table below for details).

Every effort will be made to minimise disruption and we thank you for your patience while we upgrade platform 1 at South Bank station.
