WORKS NOTICE

Day and night works

Monday 21 to Friday 25 March 2022

As part of the South Bank platform 1 upgrade, Queensland Rail will undertake platform works from **Monday 21 to Friday 25 March** (weather and construction conditions permitting).

For the safety of our customers and construction workers, some of these works have been scheduled when there is reduced rail traffic. Nearby residents may experience some noise associated with construction activity, machinery and truck movements.

A single lane closure will be in place as required on Tribune Street, South Brisbane to assist with construction works occurring over weeknights (see table below for details).

Every effort will be made to minimise disruption and we thank you for your patience while we upgrade platform 1 at South Bank station.
