WORKS NOTICE

Day, night and weekend works

April and early-May 2022

As part of the South Bank platform 1 upgrade, Queensland Rail will undertake platform works throughout April (weather and construction conditions permitting).

For the safety of our customers and construction workers, these works have been scheduled when there is reduced rail traffic, when platform 1 is temporarily closed or during a planned track closure. Nearby residents may experience some noise associated with construction activity, machinery and truck movements.

A single lane closure will be in place on Tribune Street, South Brisbane to assist with construction works occurring over weeknights and weekends (see table below for details).

Every effort will be made to minimise disruption and we thank you for your patience while we upgrade platform 1 at South Bank station.
