Project commencement - October 2021

Project overview

Queensland Rail is upgrading platform 1 at South Bank station to improve accessibility for customers and better connect with the adjacent Southpoint precinct.

The platform 1 upgrade will make it easier and safer for customers to use the station and access the connecting retail and residential precinct.

Features of the upgrade to platform 1 will include:

- a full-length raised platform
- platform seating and extended waiting shelters
- upgraded security cameras and lighting at assisted boarding points
- new wayfinding and platform signage.

Early works for the project, which will include site establishment activities, are planned for **September 2021**, with main construction due to commence in **October 2021**.

Work program

Upgrade works will be carried out on select weeknights, which we will notify the local community of directly and in advance. Temporary platform 1 closures will also be in place over 16 nominated weekends in 2021 and 2022. *Please refer to page 2 for a full list of the nominated weekend closures.*

During these weekends, trains will run express through platform 1 at South Bank. Platforms 2/3 will operate as normal and only outbound trains will be affected.

Nearby residents may experience some noise associated with construction activity, heavy machinery and truck movements. Mobile lighting towers will be used during night works.

Every effort will be made to minimise disruption and we thank you for your patience while we upgrade platform 1 at South Bank station.

Nominated weekend closures

Platform 1 will be temporarily closed on the following nominated weekends in 2021 and 2022.

Service changes

During these weekend closures, all timetabled platform 1 services to Cleveland, Beenleigh and the Gold Coast will run express from South Brisbane to Park Road stations - these services will not stop at South Bank.

Platforms 2/3 will remain open and all inbound services will operate as normal. Customers can continue to use platforms 2/3 at South Bank station during the platform 1 closures.

Alternative transport

Customers are encouraged to use Park Road or South Brisbane as an alternative station during platform 1 works. If you are travelling outbound to South Bank station, you can disembark at Park Road and catch any inbound service back to platform 2/3 at South Bank station.

Alternatively, if you are travelling outbound to South Bank station, you can disembark at South Brisbane station and walk 850 metres to South Bank station (approximately 11 minutes walk).

Customers at South Bank station who need to catch a Cleveland, Beenleigh or Gold Coast line service, can catch any inbound service from platform 2/3 and transfer to an outbound train service at South Brisbane.

Alternatively, if you are travelling outbound from South Bank station, you can catch a bus service from the South Bank busway station to Park Road and transfer to an outbound train service.

Please allow an additional 30 minutes for travel if your journey is affected during a platform 1 closure.
