

SEQ Rail Stabling Program - Banyo Construction update

Throughout May and June 2016, Queensland Rail and CPB Contractors continue construction activities as part of the SEQ Rail Stabling Program.

From Monday 9 May until early June 2016, work is planned on the western side of the railway line from the northern end of the Banyo train station, to adjacent to Purchase Street.

Works will include identifying underground services, installing temporary fencing along the footpath and the removal of the existing fence, as well as, installing foundations for signal equipment masts.

To allow these works to occur, **access to the north western end of the Banyo station will be closed to pedestrians from 9.30am Monday 9 May to 3pm Saturday 14 May 2016.**

Pedestrians will be able to access Banyo station via Purchase Street and Tufnell Road. Changed traffic conditions, including reduced speed limits and short traffic delays, may be experienced on Purchase Street and Railway Parade. Traffic controllers will be on site when required to assist with changes to pedestrian and vehicle movements.



Work impacts will include:

- Use of machinery such as excavators, vacuum excavation truck, mobile cranes, front-end loaders, generators and concreting trucks
- Delivery trucks and workers' vehicles entering the site via Purchase Street
- Use of small power tools such as drills, saws and minor vibratory equipment
- Delivery and unloading of materials.
