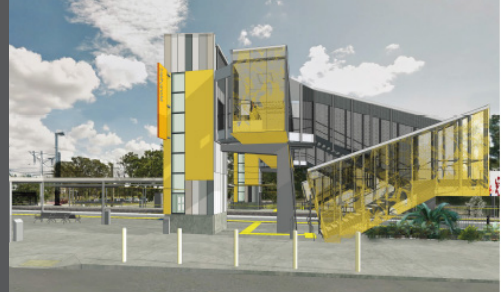


Morayfield station accessibility upgrade



Night works noise notice

Tuesday 17 to Friday 20 October 2017

Queensland Rail is striving to become a modern, customer-focused rail service and is investing significantly to upgrade a number of stations to ensure that all customers can travel safely and easily.

Early works for the Morayfield station accessibility upgrade will soon commence with the establishment of temporary platforms. To facilitate this activity, Queensland Rail plans to establish foundations for overhead equipment during scheduled night closures during October.
