## Night works noise notice

Queensland Rail is striving to become a modern, customer-focused rail service and is investing significantly to upgrade a number of stations to ensure that all customers can travel safely and easily.

Early works for the Strathpine station accessibility upgrade will soon commence with the establishment of temporary platforms. To facilitate this activity, Queensland Rail plans to undertake works on the overhead lines and tracks during scheduled night closures during October.

This will involve: <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• cranes to lift beams into place</li><li>• heavy machinery including loaders, rollers and trucks with reversing beepers</li><li>• the use of small tools including hammers and drills</li><li>• portable lighting towers.</li></ul>
