As part of early works for the Boondall station accessibility upgrade, Queensland Rail will undertake overhead line works during weeknights at the end of May 2018. Due to the nature of these works, they must be undertaken at night when there is a reduction in services.

Residents in the local area may experience some noise and lighting associated with construction activities at Boondall station. Queensland Rail appreciates your patience and apologises for the inconvenience while these works are undertaken.
