



## SEQ Rail Stabling Program

### Banyo stabling facility and Boondall night works

As part of the SEQ Rail Stabling Program, Queensland Rail and CPB Contractors will be undertaking final commissioning activities at the Banyo stabling facility on **Monday 25 and Tuesday 26 September 2017**, and at Boondall station from **Sunday 24 to Thursday 28 September 2017**.

During this work, the lighting at the Banyo stabling yard will be set to 50% intensity to enable a safe working environment.

These activities will occur outside normal working hours, as outlined below:

Aberdeen Parade, north of Boondall station	<b>9pm to 6am each night on:</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>Sunday 24 September</li><li>Monday 25 September</li><li>Tuesday 26 September</li><li>Wednesday 27 September</li><li>Thursday 28 September</li></ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>Installation and commissioning of overhead equipment</li></ul>

#### You will notice the following around your local area and on-site during these works:

- Delivery and unloading of materials and use of machinery such as excavators, mobile cranes, front-end loaders, generators, track-mountable excavators and compaction equipment
- Use of small power tools such as drills, saws and minor vibrating equipment
- Use of on-track vehicles, mobile cranes and light towers and stabling yard lighting at 50% intensity
- Delivery trucks and workers' vehicles entering the site via Guardhouse Road, Railway Parade (north and south), Royal Parade, Purchase Street and Park Street
- Vehicle routes and works on the rail line adjacent to Aberdeen Parade, Boondall
- Changed traffic conditions, including reduced speed limits and short traffic delays, will be experienced. Traffic controllers will be on-site when required to assist with changes to pedestrian and vehicle movements.
