

# Graceville station accessibility upgrade

## Project update – May 2016

Early work at Graceville station has begun to allow main construction on the platforms and subway to begin. This upgrade is being undertaken as part of Queensland Rail's \$212 million upgrade program.

### Project progress

The following construction activities were recently completed:

- establishment of site offices and construction laydown areas adjacent to the station requiring changed pedestrian and parking conditions
- installation of temporary fencing and construction access ramps onto both platforms
- establishment of initial construction zones within the station precinct
- modifications to overhead equipment in preparation for main platform upgrade works.

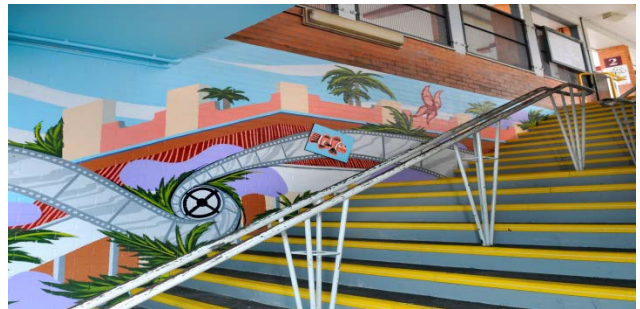
### Upcoming work

In the coming weeks, customers and the community can expect to see the following construction activities:

- changes to pedestrian access in the subway including the establishment of additional construction zones to allow for lift shaft construction work to begin
- commencement of major platform upgrade work on platforms
- installation of temporary lighting throughout the station precinct
- relocation of underground services.

### Subway and platform access

The subway will remain open for use by customers and the community throughout the upgrade. The northern subway access ramp on Honour Avenue will be closed to allow for lift construction work. All trains will depart from platforms 1 and 2.



### Construction impacts

Customers, residents and businesses adjacent to Graceville station may experience the following:

- noise associated with heavy machinery
- use of reversing beepers
- changed traffic and parking conditions
- mobile lighting towers
- increased vehicle movements around the work zones
- temporary changes to access paths throughout the station precinct.

Pedestrians and motorists are advised to follow all directional signage during this time.

Residents and other stakeholders will be given advance notification of construction activities likely to cause impacts, including after-hours work (nights and Sundays, as required).
