BE RAILSMART

Being Railsmart around the rail network is important for the safety of your family, yourself and others.

To stay safe around trains in Maryborough:

- stop, look in both directions and listen before crossing tracks
- only cross at designated crossings
- pay attention to warning signs and signals
- never enter a crossing if the red lights are flashing or solid, or the alarms are sounding
- always look for additional trains
- avoid distractions when you are crossing – turn off your headphones and don't look at your mobile phone.

Call Crime Stoppers on 1800 333 000. Those caught trespassing on the rail network can cop a fine of \$261.
