

# Temporary closure – western carpark

- 7pm Friday 21 to 6am Monday 24 September
- 7pm Monday 24 to 6am Tuesday 25 September

To enable the safe removal of the original footbridge as part of the Strathpine station accessibility upgrade, the western carpark will be unavailable from 7pm Friday 21 to 6am Monday 24 September and again overnight from 7pm Monday 24 September to 6am the next day.

A large crane will be situated in the carpark for bridge removal works.

For the safety of the public and private property, customers are requested to please assist the project team by **removing vehicles parked in the western carpark by 7pm on the day of works.**

The temporary stair-only footbridge may be open at times whenever the crane is not operating.

**Customers and members of the public seeking to cross the rail corridor are encouraged to make alternative arrangements during this time.** The eastern carpark (Gympie Road side) will remain open with some changes.

Works may be rescheduled in the event of adverse weather conditions.
