Frederick Street bridge closure and replacement Friday 31 January 2020

Queensland Rail has recently conducted a safety assessment of the Frederick Street bridge in Alderley. Extensive structural damage was identified, along with termite infestation, which has made it unsafe for pedestrians and cyclists.

To ensure the safety of users, the Frederick Street bridge will be closed permanently from **Friday 31 January 2020**. Alternative crossings are available at Alderley Avenue, Alderley and Wilston Road, Newmarket.*

The Frederick Street bridge will be removed on **Saturday 18 and Sunday 19 April 2020**, during the scheduled Ferny Grove line track closure.

Queensland Rail will engage with the local community and the Council in the coming months on replacing the bridge.



Alderley Avenue overbridge:


- 450 metres to the north
