Frederick Street bridge replacement Project update August 2022

Queensland Rail will start early works on Monday 5 September to deliver a new pedestrian and cycle bridge in Alderley, between Frederick Street and Mina Parade.

Early works involve constructing the bridge approaches on both sides including building a new accessible ramp from Frederick Street. Works will take place 6am to 6pm Monday to Saturday.





Impacts

Machinery and construction noise - Excavators, piling, jackhammering, truck movements, concrete, crane and road works.



Road closure for safety -Between 47 and 55 Frederick Street. Footpath and driveways still open.



Equipment storage Equipment will be stored
in the easement between

Waterford Street and the rail line.



Parking - Some on-street parking may be unavailable for safety reasons or if required for work vehicles.
