

Frederick Street bridge replacement Project update July 2022

Queensland Rail is working to deliver a new active transport bridge in Alderley, between Frederick Street and Mina Parade.

In early-2020, the bridge was removed due to structural issues and to ensure the safety of the local community. Since then, work has been ongoing to design a new bridge for the community and the concept designs are now available for the public to view.

Queensland Rail staff will be on-site at Alderley station to present the new concept designs and answer any questions **between 7.30am and 9.30am on Tuesday 12 July.**

Works are expected to commence later this year in preparation for the new bridge to be installed and operational by late-2023.
