WORKS NOTICE

Night works - platform works August and September 2021

As part of the Cannon Hill station accessibility upgrade, Queensland Rail will undertake platform works from **Monday 23 to Friday 27 August** and **Monday 30 August to Thursday 2 September** (weather and construction conditions permitting).

For safety, these works have been scheduled after hours when there is reduced rail traffic and the overhead power is switched off.

Nearby residents may experience some noise associated with construction activity and machinery. Mobile lighting towers will be used during the night works.

Every effort will be made to minimise disruption and we thank you for your patience while we build you a better Cannon Hill station.
