## Night works – platform activities

### November 2019

As part of the Boondall station accessibility upgrade, works will be undertaken over five nights from **Sunday 10 to Thursday 14 November, from 8pm to 6am** the next day (weather and construction conditions permitting).

For safety, these works can only be undertaken after hours, when there is no rail traffic and no customers on the platforms.

Residents near the station may experience some noise associated with construction activity and truck movements. Mobile lighting towers will be used during night works.

Every effort will be made to minimise disruption and we apologise for any inconvenience as we work to improve your station.
