WORKS NOTICE

Weekend works and road closure – Aberdeen Parade

- Road closed: 1am Saturday 13 to 10pm Sunday 14 July 2019
- Extended works: 1am Saturday 13 to 10pm Sunday 14 July 2019

As part of the Boondall station accessibility upgrade, Queensland Rail will temporarily close Aberdeen Parade between Bard Street and Stanworth Road from **1am Saturday 13 to 10pm Sunday 14 July 2019**. These works are being undertaken during a scheduled weekend track closure, when there is no rail traffic and the overhead power is switched off (see table over the page for details of works).

This temporary road closure is required to allow for the safe completion of crane lifts to install the new footbridge. During this time a traffic diversion will be in place (see map, right) and the TransLink bus stop will be relocated to Bard Street.

Local access will be maintained at the instruction of the traffic controllers. Pedestrian access will be maintained on the eastern (or residential) side of Aberdeen Parade.

Motorists, pedestrians and cyclists should observe the changed traffic conditions and follow the instructions of the traffic controller.

For the safety of the public during the station and track closure, there will be no public pedestrian access to the work zones throughout the station precinct. The ramp/footbridge will remain open to pedestrians crossing the rail corridor.

On Saturday 13 July, a large crane will be set up in Aberdeen Parade from 2am and the new footbridge will be delivered to site at 3am. Every effort will be made to minimise disruption and we apologise for any inconvenience as we work to improve your station.

Residents near the station and Aberdeen Parade work zone may experience some noise associated with construction activity and truck movements. Mobile lighting towers will be used during night works.

During the scheduled track closure, rail replacement buses will operate from the temporary TransLink bus stop in Bard Street.

Queensland Rail's Boondall station accessibility upgrade is part of the program to upgrade stations across the South East Queensland network, making them accessible for all customers.
