

Dinmore station accessibility upgrade

Project update – June 2017

The Dinmore station accessibility upgrade is part of Queensland Rail's \$212 million station upgrade program and is expected to be completed in mid-2017, weather and construction conditions permitting.

Project progress

The following construction activities were recently undertaken at Dinmore:

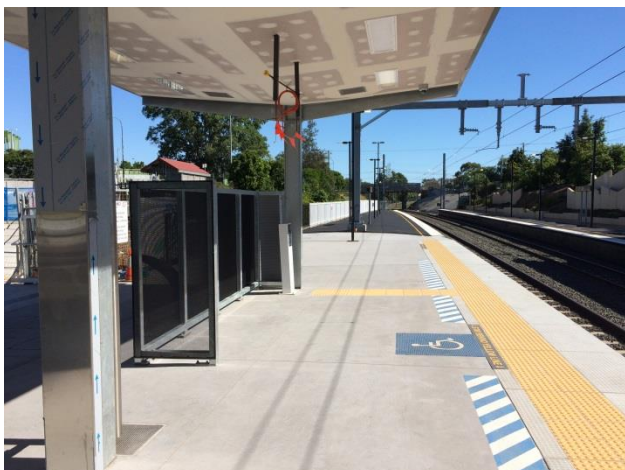
- resurfacing of platform ends
- opening of new accessible parking and motorcycle bays
- opening of new Mason Street station entrance.

Upcoming work

In the coming weeks, customers and the community can expect to see the following construction activities:

- painting works
- installation of tactile indicators
- demobilisation of construction compound and site offices.

The station carparks used for construction compounds will be progressively reinstated and returned to service throughout June.



Construction impacts

Customers and residents adjacent to Dinmore station may experience:

- noise associated with heavy machinery
- use of reversing beepers
- mobile lighting towers for night works
- changed traffic and parking conditions
- increased vehicle movements around the work zone.

Pedestrians are asked to follow all directional signage during this time and please take care around the work zones.
