Merivale Bridge maintenance works

Overview of planned after hours painting works

Queensland Rail is undertaking essential maintenance works on the Merivale Bridge over the Brisbane River. The bridge is a vital transport link in South East Queensland, serving as Brisbane's only inner-city river rail crossing.

In addition to regular works (6.30am to 6.30pm, Monday to Saturday), painting works at night will commence from Tuesday 23 May 2017 and continue, each night Monday to Sunday, throughout June.

Upcoming activities will also include continuous works undertaken during a scheduled track closure from **2am Saturday 20 May to 3am Monday 22 May 2017**.

These works must be undertaken after hours when rail traffic volumes are at their lowest.
