Merivale Bridge maintenance works

Planned weekend works

Essential maintenance works on Merivale Bridge over the Brisbane River are nearing completion.

Works will be undertaken from **5.30am to 5.30pm each day**, during a scheduled weekend track closure on **Saturday 17 and Sunday 18 February 2018**.

The Merivale Bridge was constructed in 1978 and is a vital link in South East Queensland's rail network. Project works have included cleaning and painting of the bridge deck, cables and arches, transom (sleeper) replacement and installation of a permanent maintenance gantry, stair access and walkways.
