Merivale Bridge maintenance works

Overview of planned after hours works

Queensland Rail is continuing essential maintenance works on Merivale Bridge over the Brisbane River.

In addition to regular daytime, continuous works will be undertaken during a scheduled track closure from **2am Saturday 11 to 3am Monday 13 November, 2017**. Some preparatory scaffolding works will be undertaken during normal working hours in the week prior to the track closure.

Traffic management will be in place for the safety of pedestrians and cyclists and to assist with Parmalat truck movements. Please follow the instructions of the traffic controller.

Brisbane River operators and users are advised to expect changed conditions, take care and follow the posted signs. Refer to Maritime Safety Queensland notifications.

Nearby residents and businesses may experience increased noise, lighting and construction activity in the area.

Every effort will be made to carry out these works with minimal disruption and we thank the local community for their cooperation during these important works.

While this project's main bridge painting and maintenance works are complete, remaining walkway installation works will be undertaken during a scheduled track closure in March 2018, weather and construction conditions permitting.
