## Night works – platform surfacing activities

### Monday 2 and Tuesday 3 December 2019

As part of the Morayfield station accessibility upgrade, night works will be undertaken **Monday 2 and Tuesday 3 December**, between **8pm and 6am** the next day (weather and construction conditions permitting).

For safety, these works can only be undertaken at night, when there is reduced rail traffic and the least impact to customers.

Residents near the station may experience some noise associated with construction activity and truck movements. Mobile lighting towers will be used during night works.

Every effort will be made to minimise disruption and we apologise for any inconvenience as we work to improve your station.
