

# Morayfield station accessibility upgrade

## Night and weekend works – scheduled track closure

### Saturday 16 and Sunday 17 February 2019

As part of the Morayfield station accessibility upgrade, weekend works will be undertaken at the station on **Saturday 16 and Sunday 17 February 2019**.

These works are being undertaken during a scheduled track closure, when the station is closed and rail replacement buses will operate.

Residents near the station may experience some noise associated with construction activity and truck movements. Mobile lighting towers will be used during night works.

Works include drilling (bored piling) deep into the ground to form the foundations for the raised platforms. The platform surface disturbed by works will be reinstated to ensure the platform is ready for customers on Monday morning.

For the safety of the public during the station and track closure, there will be no public pedestrian access through the station precinct, including carparks, and the footbridge will be closed.
