

Nambour station accessibility upgrade

Laneway use – March 2017

As part of the Nambour station accessibility upgrade, construction trucks will need to use the laneway behind Currie Street, accessed from Price Street, during March 2017.

Construction trucks will be using the laneway more frequently to support the work that is starting on the northern end of the platform. The laneway will still be available to Currie Street businesses to use for their normal access, parking and deliveries.

Access to businesses and private property will be maintained throughout works. If a truck is blocking your access, please speak to a member of the work crew to arrange for the vehicle to be moved as soon as possible. Short delays may occur.
