

Nambour station accessibility upgrade

Project completion –
September 2017

The Nambour station accessibility upgrade is complete, delivering improved access for all customers including those with disabilities, the elderly, parents with prams, people with injuries or those with luggage.

Features of the upgrade

The project focused on providing accessibility improvements to the station and its facilities, allowing all customers to travel safely and easily.

Features of the upgraded station include:

- accessible station entrance (concourse)
- refurbished subway and an accessible lift
- customer information display screens
- raised platform sections for improved access to trains
- additional waiting shelters on the platforms
- accessible toilets for customers, including baby change facilities
- additional accessible parking in the Price Street (western) carpark
- passenger drop-off and loading bays in Civic Way, including provision for accessible vehicles
- upgraded hearing augmentation loop and tactile platform surfaces to assist those with hearing or vision impairments
- improved CCTV and lighting.
