

Nambour station accessibility upgrade

Project update – February 2017

The Nambour station accessibility upgrade is part of Queensland Rail's \$212 million station upgrade program.

Project progress

The following construction activities were recently completed:

- ongoing subway works
- painting the station building
- associated track works.

Upcoming work

In the coming weeks, customers and the community can expect to see the following construction activities:

- construction of the new subway stairs
- reopening the island platform (southern end of station)
- commencement of work on the northern end of platform 1
- construction of the new toilet facilities
- completion of the subway and lift.

Continuous access to the station office will be provided via either Civic Way or the platform-side entrance.

Platform changes

The upgraded island platform (southern end of the station) is expected to reopen to customers next month. At this time the northern end of platform 1 will close for upgrade works.


There will be some access changes around the station during this phase of works.

Platform announcements, signage and station staff will assist customers. Please take care around the work zones.

Pedestrian subway

The pedestrian subway is being upgraded with new lighting, CCTV, tactile surfaces and wall art being installed this month. Queensland artist Simon de Groot has taken inspiration from the Nambour built environment and designed an artwork concept (below) bringing together shapes used in both historic and modern local buildings.



When the subway is reopened to the public in March, the courtesy shuttle bus service will cease operation.

Construction impacts

Customers, residents and businesses adjacent to Nambour station may experience the following:

- noise associated with heavy machinery
- use of vehicles with reversing beepers
- changed traffic and parking conditions
- some night works.

Residents and other stakeholders will be given advance notification of construction activities likely to cause impacts, including after hours work (nights and Sundays, as required).
