

Nambour station accessibility upgrade

Project update – January 2017

The Nambour station accessibility upgrade is entering its final stage with work set to begin shortly on the northern section of the platform.

Project progress

The following construction activities were recently completed:

- pavement resurfacing and installation of tactile ground surface indicators outside station office
- lift shaft construction
- installation of passenger information display screens on island platform
- awning and lighting on station building
- refurbishment of subway walls.

Upcoming work

In the coming weeks, customers and the community can expect to see the following construction activities:

- demolition of shelters and light poles on the northern end of the platform
- lift installation.

Continuous access to the station office will be provided via either Civic Way or the platform-side entrance.

Please follow directional signage or see station staff for assistance.

Platform changes

During February the island platform will be reopened for customers, and the temporary platform will be closed and removed.

At the same time, the northern end of platform 1 will be temporarily closed. Trains will stop in two stages on the southern end of the platform so that customers in all carriages can board and disembark.

Platform announcements and signage will be used to assist customers during this time.



Construction impacts

Customers, residents and businesses adjacent to Nambour station may experience the following:

- noise associated with heavy machinery
- use of reversing beepers
- changed traffic and parking conditions
- increased vehicle movements around the work zones, especially in Civic Way
- some night works.

Residents and other stakeholders will be given advance notification of construction activities likely to cause impacts, including after hours work (nights and Sundays, as required).
