

Nambour station accessibility upgrade Night Works – February-March 2017

As part of the Nambour station accessibility upgrade, **platform works** will occur nightly between 10pm and 5am the next morning, from **Monday 20 February to Friday 3 March 2017**. (Works will be undertaken on Sunday to Friday nights only.)

Works will include the removal of concrete from the platform by excavator with jack hammering attachment.

For safety, these activities can only be undertaken at night when there are no customers on the platform. Once the refurbished (southern) section of platform reopens and the upgrade moves to the northern end of the platform, these works will continue during the day inside the work zone closed to the public.

Every effort will be made to carry out these works with minimal disruption. Queensland Rail apologises for any inconvenience and thanks the local community for their cooperation during these important works.
