

Auchenflower station accessibility upgrade



PROJECT UPDATE – FEBRUARY 2021

The Auchenflower station accessibility upgrade is part of the State Government's investment of more than \$500 million to upgrade stations across the South East Queensland network, making them accessible for all customers.

Project progress

Works recently undertaken at Auchenflower include:


- overhead line and track works
- piling (foundations) for platform and bridge structures
- stormwater and sewer excavations
- excavation to create working area behind platforms 1 and 4
- track works to adjust rail height
- rail systems (signalling) relocations
- partial platform raising (pictured, right).

Upcoming works

In the next month, the following activities will be undertaken:

- ongoing platform works
- ongoing station design activities (off-site)
- excavation of lift pits
- in-ground service relocations.

Please take care around the work zones.



Construction impacts

During works, construction activities may involve:

- changed parking and traffic conditions for safety
- noise associated with heavy machinery
- temporary changes to access paths throughout the station precinct and surrounding areas
- relocated ticketing equipment and platform facilities
- increased vehicle movements near works
- mobile lighting towers for night works.

Normal working hours are 6.30am to 6.30pm, Monday to Saturday.

The local community will be given advance notification of construction activities likely to cause impacts, including after hours work (nights, Sundays and public holidays, if required).
