

Auchenflower station accessibility upgrade



PROJECT UPDATE – JANUARY 2022

The Auchenflower station accessibility upgrade is part of the State Government's ongoing investment of more than \$500 million to upgrade stations across the South East Queensland network, making them accessible for all customers.

Project progress

Works recently undertaken at Auchenflower include:

- installation of pedestrian walkway infrastructure
- continuing lift shaft installation
- continuing footbridge and staircase works
- partial raising of platform 2/3
- partial raising of platform 1
- temporary closure of the station carpark to support upgrade and demolition works
- reopening of Auchenflower Terrace.

Upcoming works

In the coming weeks, customers and the community can expect to see the following activities:

- ongoing platform works
- new entrance works (Auchenflower Terrace and Lang Parade)
- installation of new main electrical switchboard
- works in the old station building/concourse in preparation for demolition
- setting up a large crane in the station carpark
- fit-out of new footbridge, walkway and ticket office
- establishment of a temporary ticket office (near corner of Auchenflower Terrace and Ridley Street).

Please take care around the work zones.



Construction impacts

During works, construction activities may involve:

- changed parking and traffic conditions for safety
- noise associated with heavy machinery
- temporary changes to access paths throughout the station precinct and surrounding areas
- relocated ticketing equipment and platform facilities
- increased vehicle movements near works
- mobile lighting towers for night works.

Normal working hours are 6.30am to 6.30pm, Monday to Saturday.

The local community will be given advance notification of construction activities likely to cause impacts, including after hours work (nights, Sundays and public holidays, if required).
