

East Ipswich station accessibility upgrade



PROJECT UPDATE – APRIL 2021

The East Ipswich station accessibility upgrade is part of the State Government's ongoing investment of more than \$500 million to upgrade stations across the South East Queensland network, making them accessible for all customers.

Project progress

The following works have been undertaken recently at East Ipswich:

- concrete pours – new platforms
- installation of services/conduits
- stair footings
- commenced works on existing platforms
- commenced precast lift shafts.

Upcoming works

In the coming weeks customers and the community can expect to see the following activities:

- continuing precast lift shaft works
- continuing stormwater and sewage works, including tree removal (Merton Street)
- removal of heritage shelter (to be relocated to new platform)
- raising of sections of the existing platforms
- fabrication of new footbridge and stairs (off-site)
- delivery of new footbridge components and assembly on-site (Coronation Street compound)
- commencement of lift installation.



Construction impacts

During works, construction activities may involve:

- changed parking and traffic conditions for safety
- noise associated with heavy machinery
- temporary changes to access paths throughout the station precinct and surrounding areas
- increased vehicle movements near works
- mobile lighting towers for night works.

Normal working hours are 6.30am to 6.30pm, Monday to Saturday.

The local community will be given advance notification of construction activities likely to cause impacts, including after hours work (nights, Sundays and public holidays, if required).
