

Strathpine station accessibility upgrade



PROJECT UPDATE – JUNE 2019

Queensland Rail's Strathpine station accessibility upgrade is part of the program to upgrade stations across the South East Queensland network, making them accessible for all customers.

Project progress

Last month, the following activities were undertaken:

- works to underground services including tree removal – eastern carpark
- concrete pour:
 - lift shaft walls – platforms 1 and 2/3
 - footbridge and stair footings – platform 2/3
 - footbridge support column – western carpark
- crane lift to install new footbridge and platform 2/3 staircase – track closure, early June (pictured).



Upcoming works

In the coming weeks, customers and the community can expect to see the following activities:

- installation of lift shafts – platform 1 and western carpark
- installation of footbridge stairs – platform 1 and western carpark
- demolition of redundant structures – platform 2/3
- ongoing excavation works – platform 2/3.

Construction impacts

Normal working hours are 6am to 5pm, Monday to Saturday. Construction activities may involve:

- noise associated with heavy machinery
- temporary changes to access paths throughout the station precinct
- ramp access to platform 2/3 (at level crossing) closed throughout construction
- changed traffic and parking conditions
- increased vehicle movements near works
- mobile lighting towers for night works.

Please follow all directional signage and take care around the work zones.
