## Night works – platform works

### Sunday 19 January 2020

In preparation for the reopening of the upgraded platform 2/3, as part of the Strathpine station accessibility upgrade, preparation works will be undertaken at night from **11pm Sunday 19 January until 6am** the next day (weather and construction conditions permitting).

Works are not expected to create excessive noise and will include painting and the removal/relocation of safety fencing.

For the safety of customers and project workers, these works can only be carried out when there is no rail traffic.

Residents near the station may experience some noise associated with platform activities and truck movements. Mobile lighting towers will be used, as required, during night works.
