Night works – electrical works

Tuesday 11 February 2020

As part of the Strathpine station accessibility upgrade, electrical works will be undertaken overnight on **Tuesday 11 February** from **10pm to 6am** the next day (weather and construction conditions permitting).

Residents near the station may experience some noise associated with personnel and vehicles around the station precinct.

Activities include the use of generators. Mobile lighting towers will be used, as required, during night works.
